





· Attendance



- TEXAS REQUIRES A CHILD WHO IS AT LEAST 6 YEARS OF AGE, OR WHO IS YOUNGER THAN 6 YEARS OF AGE AND HAS PREVIOUSLY BEEN ENROLLED IN FIRST GRADE, AND WHO HAS NOT YET REACHED HIS/HER 18TH BIRTHDAY TO ATTEND SCHOOL UNLESS EXEMPT BY LAW. STUDENTS ENROLLED IN PREKINDERGARTEN OR KINDERGARTEN SHALL ATTEND SCHOOL
- Under Texas Education Code 25.094, a student is in violation of the Compulsory Attendance Law if the student is absent 3 days or parts of days in a four week period or IO days or parts of days in a six month period. Tardiness is considered part of a school day. It is the responsibility of the parent to monitor their child's attendance.
