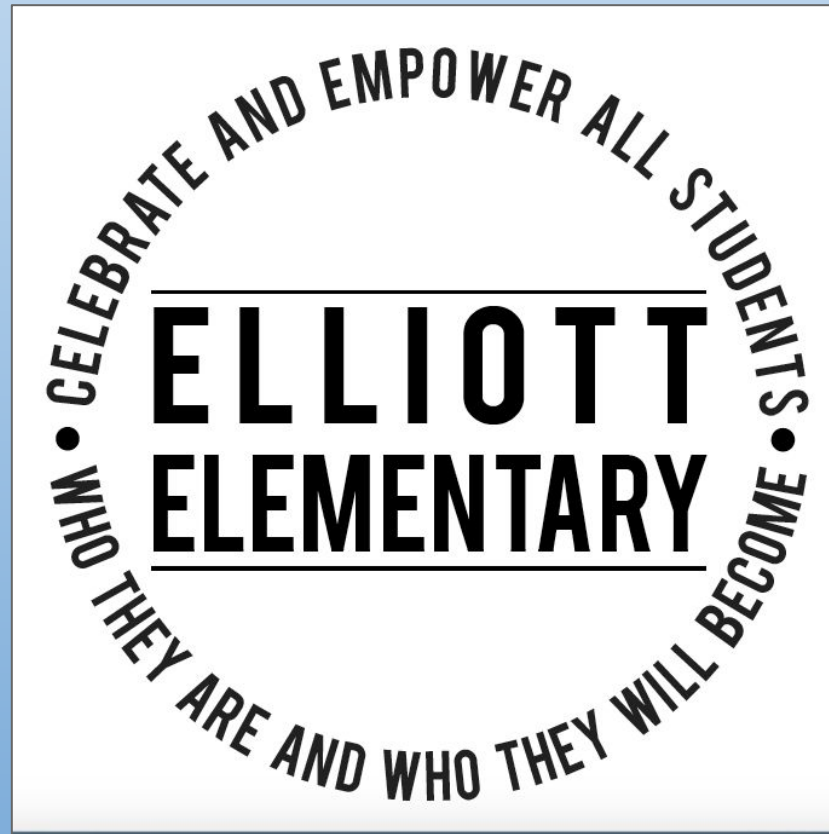

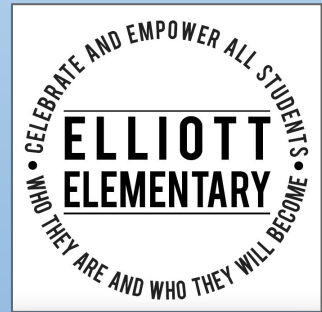
Mission

Our intentionally collaborative team:

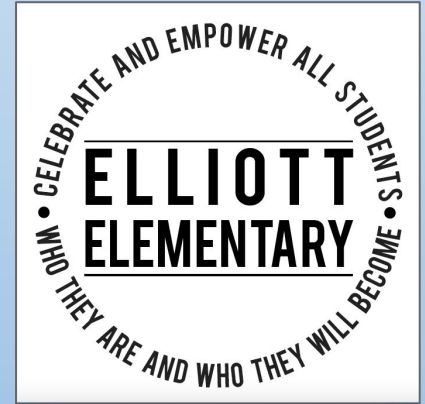
- ❑ seeks first to understand,

- ❑ frequently communicates student progress, and believes we can lead each student to meet or exceed grade level standards and close achievement gaps in literacy, math, and science.



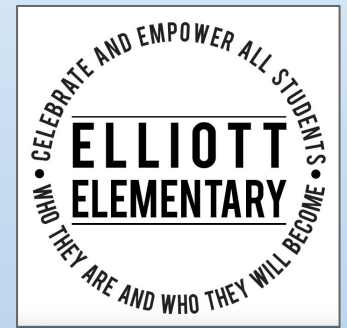
We Benefit from Title One Funds!

 - ❑ significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach, at a minimum, proficiency on challenging state academic achievement standards and state academic assessments.

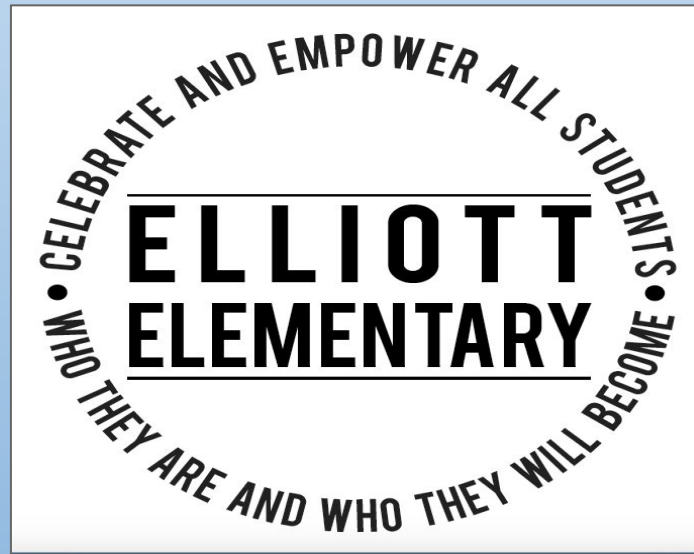


How is Funding Determined?
