PTA REFLECTIONS PROGRAM 2015-2016 "LET YOUR IMAGINATION FLY"



This year's PTA Reflections Theme is "Let Your Imagination Fly!"

Reflections is a National PTA Program designed to cultivate achievement in the Arts.

It is open to children in grades Pre-K through grade 12.

There are six areas where students have the opportunity to express themselves creatively through their Reflections Projects: **Photography**, **Visual Arts**, **Literature**, **Dance Choreography**, **Film Production and Musical Composition**. Artwork should be inspired and created by the student. Entries will be judged on interpretation of the theme as well as skill.

Submitted artwork will be judged first at Purefoy by a panel of judges. Qualifying student entries will be sent to compete at the State Level.

The deadline to enter is October 23, 2015

Special Artist Division

The Texas PTA Reflections program is also accepting entries for the Special Artist Division. The Special Artist Division is limited to students whose physical, cognitive, or mental health challenges meet ADA guidelines. Qualifying students entering this division create their own artwork but may receive non-artistic accommodation and assistance from an adult. At the national level, one Special Artist from across all arts categories will be selected to receive an Outstanding Interpretation Award. Up to five additional Special Artists may be selected to receive national Awards of Excellence. Our hope is that you will encourage your child to participate in the Reflections Program. This program is wonderful opportunity for your child to enhance his/her artistic abilities. The program helps encourage creativity and lifelong learning and offers recognition for your child's artistic endeavors.

Click on Current Volunteer Opportunities to access jobs we are currently looking to fill. Choose the one that's a good fit for you and sign up. Each job has a description, date, and time. This section is updated throughout the year. So keep checking!

Step 4: Attend Volunteer Orientation and Sign a Statement of Commitment

Volunteers must attend just ONE TIME. There is no need to attend yearly. The orientation will discuss Frisco ISD procedures and school policies, guidelines on confidentiality, and expectations of volunteers.
