What time can I drop my child off at Scott?

Students are allowed in the Café beginning at 7:10 each morning. While teachers are not required to be on duty until 7:20, we are lucky to have some who are willing to open early for the families that need a few extra minutes.

What is the best time to drop my child off?

Please drop your child off between 7:20 and 7:40. Arrival tends to back up between 7:40 and 7:50 so plan accordingly.

What time does school begin and end at Scott Elementary?

School begins at 7:50 but students are released to their classrooms at 7:30. Students are dismissed from school at 2:50.

How do I change my child's dismissal?

All changes to dismissal must be made before 12:00 p.m. Please email your child's teacher with the changes. If you are not able to email, please contact the front office at 469-633-4000.

How is the arrival/dismissal/crosswalk and flow of traffic determined.

The City of McKinney is responsible for determining the safest traffic routes. They have evaluated and determined the best arrival and dismissal patterns. During the first few weeks of school, please be patient as our teachers ensure every child safely arrives and dismisses in the correct manner.

Where do I go if I do not see my child at dismissal?

A staff member will use their walkie to contact your child's teacher and locate your child quickly and safely.

How will my child's teacher communicate with me?

Teachers at Scott Elementary believe that communication is one of the most important parts of a child's education. Your child's grade level website plus a host of other resources can be found here. Teachers will send out weekly emails that provide curriculum updates and classroom information. Thursday Folders will come home weekly with your child's graded work and important papers. Please make sure that you look through these folders for important communication from your child's teacher.
