



# PSAT – October 10<sup>th</sup>

## **READY TO APPLY?**

#### Narrow down your list of Colleges

2 Safety Colleges; 2 Probable Colleges; 2 Reach Colleges

Safety: You already meet the college's admission requirements Probable: Your GPA, test scores and course selections Are similar to students already admitted

Reach: You have a chance of getting into this college, but your GPA, test scores and course grades are on the low side when you view the college's profile.

If you are interested in Collin, right now list it as one of your safety schools. You will get admitted. Please still explore/research other colleges because you may have to transfer from Collin to earn your 4 year Degree at another college.

# College Application Process

- Visit each university's admission website. Find out the application requirements, deadlines and preferred methods of applying.
- Complete the online application before the deadline.
- Request official test scores from College Board (SAT) and ACT to the college you are applying to 3 weeks in advance.
- Send your official transcript to the college (s) from Parchment.
- Request letters of recommendation only if <u>REQUIRED!</u> Common App. Always requires teacher and counselor recommendation.

## **APPLICATION TYPES**

**Apply Texas** - accepted by all public colleges and many private colleges in Texas.

www.applytexas.org

**Common Application** - accepted by over 600 universities from across the country (many which are private)

www.commonapp.org

\*\*\*VERY Important, If you apply to colleges using the Common Application PLEASE inform your counselors\*\*\*\*

**Individual College Applications** - many institutions have their own unique applications.

How do you know which application to use? When in doubt, check each college's admissions website.

Write down all important deadlines for admission...application deadline, scholarship deadline, housing deadline, etc.

# DO I HAVE TO TAKE THE TSI? WHAT IS THAT?

- The Texas Success Initiative (TSI) is a program designed to determine if a student is ready for college-level course work in the general areas of reading, writing and mathematics. This program will also help determine what type of course or intervention will best meet the student's needs and to assist in becoming better prepared for college-level course work.
- Required for ALL new college students unless exempt

#### Exemptions

- A student is exempt on the basis of **SAT I** scores (less than 5 years old) with a minimum qualifying combined score of 1070, utilizing Reading and Math only, with at least 500 Reading and at least 500 Math.
- A student is exempt on the basis of the **ACT** (less than 5 years old) with a minimum qualifying score of 23 composite, with at least 19 English and at least 19 Math.

## COUNSELOR LETTER OF REC.

Request a recommendation letter from your counselor by email or in person at least <u>3 school weeks</u> (not holidays) in advance before it must be submitted online or mailed.

You must complete the letter of request form on the IHS website.

Princeton

This will send an email request directly to your counselor giving us the due date, colleges, and other info. we need.

Follow-up with your counselor and express your appreciation.

# REQUESTING A TEACHER LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

- Ask your teacher in person for a recommendation least 3 weeks before it must be submitted online or mailed.
- At the meeting, provide your teacher with the application deadlines, resume and any other requested materials from the teacher. If the letter must be mailed, provide an addressed stamped envelope. Use the school's address for the return address.
- For the Common Application teacher recommendation, let your teacher's know they will receive an email requesting the recommendation.
- Follow up with the teacher and write a thank you note.


## **ARMED SERVICES TEST - ASVAB**

- ASVAB offered at CTEC on October 16<sup>th</sup> 5-7 pm.
  - An aptitude test that measures strengths and weaknesses for future college, career, and military plans
  - The Armed Forces Qualification Test (AFQT) is part of the ASVAB requirement for entrance into the military
- You will get an email when it is time to sign up!

# **HOW DO I REQUEST MY TRANSCRIPT?**

- Official transcripts- request online from Parchment.
- Unofficial transcripts- print off of HAC

# FISD Rank Changes on Transcript

- Frisco ISD will only rank the Top 10% of students (required by Texas Law)
- All other students will <u>only</u> have their GPA reported on your transcript.
- We will share GPA cut-offs for each quartile so you know where you fall (rank will be re-ran mid-September for seniors).
  - Top 25%
  - Top 50%
  - Top 75%

### RANK CHANGES- HOLISTIC REVIEW

This FORCES colleges to look at your courses, grades, PAP/AP classes, etc. (This is a GOOD thing!)

- Achievements
- **Extracurricular activities**
- Work/Life Experiences
- Community Service
- Talents

### Texas A&M Example:

First: Admissions will look at your transcript and the school profile and determine a rank/quartile for you.

Then: Holistic review process will proceed... TAMU will use all information in your application- so make sure to do your very best, this is where you will SHINE!

## TOP 10% RULE

- A student is eligible for automatic admission to a public college or university as an undergraduate student if the applicant earned a GPA in the top 10 percent of the student's high school graduating class, or the top 6 percent for Fall 2019 admission to the University of Texas at Austin.
- Your application and all required paperwork must be submitted on time to qualify!
- 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Enrollment Currently is 520 seniors

# \$ APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL AID

 Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Online Application is available October 1st!

www.fafsa.ed.gov

- If you Qualify, you may receive the following:
- Loan- low interest and pay back after you graduate from college
- Employment- an opportunity to receive an oncampus job
- Grants- free money that does not have to be paid back
- Scholarships- free money that usually requires maintaining a certain GPA

# HOW DO I FIND SCHOLARSHIPS THIS YEAR?

- District Scholarship List will be shared soon! (large list of scholarships that will continually be updated all year from FISD counselors)
- Local scholarships- Will be continually sent by email to senior students and parents, then posted in district list
- University-specific scholarships- check college webpages-scholarship and financial aid pages to see how college awards freshman scholarships




