AP Exam registration Is open!

Please see the following link for registration dates, cost of exam, refund information, etc. You are officially registered for the exam when you pay for the exam in MyPaymentsPlus, or stop by the IHS counseling office in order to pay with exact cash or check.

AP Exam Registration Information-CLICK HERE

AP exams are ONLY offered in AP courses, not PAP courses. Please check with your student before registering and paying for an exam that is not needed. Also, please check your student's schedule in HAC to ensure you are registering for the correct AP exam. Many exams have similar names. See below for some common registrations that have similar names:

• 9th graders are usually taking <u>AP Human Geography</u>. 10th graders are usually taking <u>AP World History</u>.

• 11th graders are usually taking <u>AP English Language</u>. 12th graders are usually taking <u>AP English Literature</u>.

*ALL STUDENTS are required to attend one of the Pre-Admin sessions to fill out a testing booklet. Students only need to attend one session, regardless of how many AP exams the student is taking.

*EXCEPTION: <u>AP Human Geography</u>, <u>AP World History students</u>, or <u>AP Seminar stu-</u> <u>dents</u> will fill out a testing booklet during class, so no session registration is necessary, even if the student is also taking other subject exams. Also, if your only exam is AP Art 2D or 3D, you do not need to attend a session.


ISM Applications
