



#### **IHS AP EXAM TESTERS:**

AP testing begins next week at IHS! Here are a few important reminders:

- 1) Please review the exam schedule! Know when and where you are testing. Report to morning exams no later than <u>7:30 a.m.</u>; report to afternoon exams no later than <u>11:30 a.m.</u>. Latecomers will not be allowed to test.
- 2) Rosters with room assignments have been posted in the cafeteria. Please make sure you know exactly where you are going BEFORE the day of the exam! (AP Chinese is at Liberty High School and AP Art History is at Heritage this year. All other exams are at IHS. Students testing with accommodations have been notified of their location).
- 3) Bring #2 pencils and black or blue pens with you to the exam (leave backpacks and other personal items in your locker due to space limitations).
- 4) Electronic equipment (cell phone, smart phone, smartwatch, fitbits, laptop, tablet computer, etc.), portable listening or recording devices (MP3 player, iPod, etc.), cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the Internet, and any other electronic or communication devices are PROHIBITED IN THE EX-AM ROOM per College Board. Students may not wear t-shirts with logos of subject matter.
- 5) You may bring a snack and water for the break that can be placed at the front of the testing room until break.
- 6) If you are taking <u>two</u> exams on the same day or you have an afternoon exam, <u>bring a sack lunch</u>. Report to your 2nd exam room after your first exam is over and eat your lunch while waiting for the next exam to begin!
- 7) Students cannot use highlighters on AP exams! Every year we have at least one or two incidents where students begin using a highlighter before we can stop them. This is then turned in as an irregularity, and your scores may be delayed.

Freshman and juniors students will soon be taking the Algebra, Biology, and US History EOC exams.

Algebra EOC - May 10<sup>th</sup> @ 9:00 am

Biology EOC - May 11<sup>th</sup> @ 9:00 am

<u>US History</u> – May 12<sup>th</sup> @ 9:00 am

<u>Testing Location-</u> Be at your testing location before 8:50 am on the day of the exam. Testing locations are posted in the café.

**Supplies:** Bring standard testing supplies, such as pencils, erasers, and highlighters, as well as a light sweater/jacket.

<u>Lunch/Snack:</u> Students will be given four hours to complete the test. Many students choose to also bring snacks and water. Students that complete the exam before 3<sup>rd</sup> period will be released to attend 3<sup>rd</sup> period class. All others will be released as they complete their test to attend lunch/class.

Water is the only allowed drink and must be in a clear container. No other outside drinks will be allowed.

<u>Technology: Cell phones, smart watches, tablets, iPODs, etc are NOT allowed</u> in the testing room and should be left at home or placed in your student's locker for the duration of the test. Should any of this technology be brought to the testing room, it will be collected and held for return upon completion of the school day.


