

Get Your **AP** Scores Online in July



1. EXAM TIME: FILL IN

your AP® answer sheets carefully and consistently to prevent delays in score access.

Especially your name, date of birth, sex, mailing address, and email address.



2. BEFORE JULY: SIGN UP

for a College Board account at collegeboard.org/register.

- It's best to provide the same information on your College Board account and your AP answer sheet.
- You may already have an account—try signing in to confirm. You should also doublecheck that the information you put on your answer sheet matches what's in your account, especially if you've recently changed your email address.
- If you've forgotten your username or password, you can recover them on the website.
 You shouldn't create a duplicate account.



3. IN JULY: REMEMBER

the following information to access your scores:

- Your College Board account username and password.
- Your AP number (or student ID number if you provide it on your AP answer sheet).



4. GET YOUR SCORES: LOG ON

at apscore.org.

- Check apscore.org to find the exact date when you'll be able to access your scores.
- . Look for a reminder in July at the email address you put on your AP answer sheet.

Class Rank and Transcripts

If you have questions regarding class rank, please note the following:

Frisco ISD is no longer utilizing Family Connection. An error is currently preventing class rank information for the 2017-18 school year from displaying within Home Access Center. FISD is aware of the problem and is currently working to resolve the issue, though it is unclear when the information will be available in HAC. If you would like to receive class rank information in the interim, please request your official transcript via Parchment and allow 2-3 business days for the request to be processed. Visit www.friscoisd.org and search "transcript requests" for details. If approved by the Board of Trustees on June 11, proposed changes regarding the publication of class rank would go into effect for the 2018-19 school year. The end of year transcripts for the 2017-2018 school year will include rank.
