We have become aware that student lunch deliveries have been accepted through delivery services such as Uber Eats. As stated in the Student Handbook, "Students are not allowed to order food from an outside vendor. Food deliveries placed by students will be denied." Food deliveries will only be accepted from parents. Starting Tuesday, January, 17th, IHS staff will confirm that the person delivering a lunch is a parent and if not, will turn the food delivery away. Should the driver leave the food anyway, IHS will not give the

student access to the delivery. Students requesting food delivery services to deliver in other areas of the school in an attempt to circumvent the front office will be subject to disciplinary consequences.

Also, please remember, deliveries of any type will not be made to the class-room. Any deliveries to school by a parent will be left in the front office, and students are responsible for checking for deliveries on their own between classes or at lunch. Parents are only allowed to deliver lunch for their own student(s). Food cannot be shared with others students.


