### Dan Nguyen

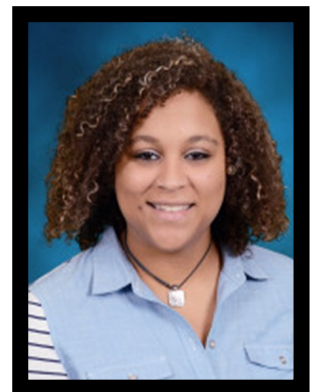

## Announcements



### **InfoSnap Information:**

Parents of all students should have received an email last week for each student enrolled at IHS this year. This email is auto-generated and sent to the email address of the first contact listed for your student. The InfoSnap email will contain a “snapcode” and a link to use for providing enrollment information for next year. **It is very important that this process is completed for every child currently enrolled.** If you have not received an InfoSnap email, please check your “spam” folder.

The deadline for completing the InfoSnap process is **June 2, 2017**.

\*\*\*Please note, the updated proof of residency referenced at the completion of the InfoSnap process is for a **JULY** or **AUGUST** utility (water, gas, or electric **only**) bill in the name of a parent/guardian listed for your student. If you provide us with a utility bill that does not reflect July or August, or if you provide a document other than a water, gas, or electric bill, you will be asked to submit a July or August water, gas, or electric bill, and this could delay your student being placed on a class list. Failing to provide a July or August water, gas, or electric bill will result in your student not being able to pick up their schedule until the appropriate bill is received.
