InfoSnap Information:

Parents of all students will be receiving an email this week for each student enrolled at IHS this year. This email is auto-generated and sent to the email address of the first contact listed for your student The InfoSnap email will contain a "snapcode" and a link to use for providing enrollment information for next year. It is very important that this process is completed for every child currently enrolled. If you have not received an InfoSnap email, please check your "spam" folder.

The deadline for completing the InfoSnap process is **June 2, 2017**.

***Please note, the updated proof of residency referenced at the completion of the InfoSnap process is for a **JULY** or **AUGUST** utility (water, gas, or electric **only**) bill in the name of a parent/guardian listed for your student. If you provide us with a utility bill that does not reflect July or August, or if you provide a document other than a water, gas, or electric bill, you will be asked to submit a July or August water, gas, or electric bill, and this could delay your student being placed on a class list. Failing to provide a July or August water, gas, or electric bill will result in your student not being able to pick up their schedule until the appropriate bill is received.

**Please note that Class of 2017 Dues are different than Senior Fees. Senior Fees were collected this year for senior activities that the Senior Parent Board organized which included the Bon Fire, Powder Puff Game, Senior Breakfast, and Six Flags trip. Those fees are different than the Class of 2017 Dues. The optional \$25 Class of 2017 Dues were collected through My Payments Plus at IHS during your student's Sophomore & Junior years. Depending on which FISD high school your student went to for 9th grade, you might have also paid Dues during their Freshman year. Mrs. Rupprecht can help you determine if you paid dues and process your refund request.
