- Wednesday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> 7:00-10:00pm Frisco Education Foundation Scholarship Awards Night @ Dr. Pepper Arena for CHS seniors receiving FEF Scholarships – invitations are sent to all awards recipients
- Thursday, May 17<sup>th</sup> CHS Senior Awards Night @ 7 pm in the CHS Auditorium for Seniors receiving CHS academic awards – invitations are sent to all awards recipients

- Wednesday, May 22<sup>nd</sup> FISD Top Ten Luncheon for the Top 10 graduating Seniors from each high school. The luncheon will be at Collin College from 11am–1:30 pm.
- Thursday, May 24th Senior Day Seniors report to CHS gym by 8:00am to take roll and confirm who will be going on the Sr. parent sponsored senior day trip. FISD dress code is enforced for this Sr. Day activity. Seniors not attending the Senior Day event will attend regular class. Sr's may not drive themselves to Six Flags.

  NOTE: Seniors may not attend the Sr. Day event if they are failing any "A or B" day class for the 6th sixweeks. The sixth six weeks begins on April 15th.

- Wednesday, May 30<sup>th</sup> Graduation practice @ 3 pm in the CHS gymnasium. Attendance at both practices is mandatory if you intend to participate in the graduation ceremony on Saturday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>. Make arrangements NOW with your work, etc. to be present at graduation practices on both Wednesday and Thursday. Community Service and Honor Cords will be handed out to seniors who qualify for them after this practice session.
- Seniors who are on the CHS **Hold List** for lost textbooks, library books, uniforms, equipment, etc. will not be allowed to participate in graduation until their outstanding debts are paid and their name is taken off the **Hold List.**

- Thursday, May 31st Graduation practice will begin @ 3 pm in the CHS gym; attendance is required. Tickets for graduation will be handed out after this practice. Each senior is guaranteed 10 free tickets with any extra tickets that are available to be dispersed after Thursday's practice. You may also ask friends for tickets they may not be using.
- If you do not plan to walk in graduation, see Mr. Sears or Mrs. Villarreal in the upstairs AP office ASAP.
- Friday, June 1st Seniors will have a final Sr. Class meeting at 11:30am in the auditorium.

- CHS Graduation Ceremony is at **4:30pm on Sat., June 2<sup>nd</sup>** @ Dr. Pepper Arena. Seniors will report to the CHS gyms on Saturday **no later than 2:00pm** and will be transported to the Dr. Pepper Arena for graduation.
- Students may not drive themselves to graduation.
- Seniors must be in normal FISD dress code and have their cap & gown in hand to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- Seniors should leave their personal items, purses, cell phones, etc. in their cars or at home as they will not be allowed to take them onto the Arena floor. Students will be provided large brown envelopes to put their keys, etc. in at CHS prior to leaving for the Arena and students can collect their envelope at the Arena doors as they exit the building following graduation. Any unclaimed envelopes will be brought back to CHS and will be available for pick up in the front office on Monday morning.
