



Medication Pick-Up Reminder All-Call 2017-2018

Hello Parents,

Friday, June 1st is the last day of school. We ask that you please come to the school clinic to pick up all of your child's medication, including Tylenol, Ibuprofen, cough drops, and Benadryl, **on or before June 1st**. Per FISD policy, students are not allowed to pick up their own medications.

Any medication left in the clinic after Friday, June 1st, will be destroyed in accordance with FISD policy.

We hope you will understand that this is a safety measure to try and prevent the medication from getting into the wrong hands. This not only protects your child, but it protects other students as well.

For safety reasons, we ask that if your child's medications include any kind of asthma medicine or an Epi Pen, that you wait until the last day of school to take your child's medications home with you.
