- Wednesday, May 22nd Frisco Education Foundation Scholarship Awards Night @ Dr. Pepper Arena for CHS seniors receiving FEF Scholarships invitations are sent to all awards recipients
- Tuesday, May 21st CHS Senior Awards Night @ 7 pm in the CHS Auditorium for Seniors receiving CHS academic awards invitations are sent to all awards recipients
- Tuesday, May 21st FISD Top Ten Luncheon for the Top 10 graduating Seniors from each high school. The luncheon will be from 11am–1:30 pm, location TBA.
- Wednesday, May 23rd Senior Day Seniors report to CHS gym by 8:00am to take roll and confirm who will be going on the Sr. parent sponsored senior day trip.

 FISD dress code is enforced for this Sr. Day activity.

 Seniors not attending the Senior Day event will attend regular class.

 NOTE: Seniors may not attend the Sr. Day event if they are failing any "A or B" day class for the 6th six-weeks. The sixth six weeks begins on April 15th.
- Tuesday, May 28th Graduation practice @ 3 pm in the CHS gymnasium. Attendance at both practices is mandatory if you intend to participate in the graduation ceremony on Saturday, June 1. Students should make arrangements NOW with work, etc. to be present at graduation practices on both Wednesday and Thursday. Community Service and Honor Cords will be handed out to seniors who qualify for them after this practice session. Seniors who are on the CHS Hold List for lost textbooks, library books, uniforms, equipment, etc. will not be allowed to participate in graduation exercises until their outstanding debts are paid and their name is taken off the Hold List.
- Wednesday, May 29th ***SENIOR FIELD DAY*** Graduation practice will begin @ **3 pm** in the CHS gym; attendance is required. **Tickets for graduation will be handed out after this practice.** Each senior is guaranteed **10 free tickets** with any extra tickets that are available to be dispersed after practice. You may also ask friends for tickets they may not be using

Thursday, May 30th Seniors will have a final Sr. Class meeting at 11:30am in the auditorium. This is a ½ day for all FISD high school.

Friday, May 31st NO SCHOOL Saturday, June 1st CHS Graduation Ceremony is at **9:30am on Saturday, June 1st** @ FORD Center at the STAR.

- Seniors will report to the CHS gyms on Friday morning no later than 7:30am and will be transported to the Dr. Pepper Star Center by CHS transportation services for graduation. Students may not drive themselves to the graduation ceremony.
- Seniors must be in normal FISD dress code and have their cap & gown in hand to participate in the graduation ceremony. Students are not permitted to wear jeans, tennis shoes, flip flops or pants with holes in them to the graduation ceremony. This is a formal event and student dress should reflect that standard.
- Students may not paint or design their caps for graduation.
- Seniors should leave their personal items, purses, cell phones, etc. in their cars or
 at home as they will not be allowed to take them onto the Arena floor. Students
 will be provided large brown envelopes to put their keys, etc. in at CHS prior to
 leaving for the Arena and students can collect their envelope at CHS in the front
 office on Monday morning. Students are not allowed back stage after the
 ceremony.
- The clear bag security policy/procedure will be in place during graduation ceremonies for all guests/audience.
- There will be concessions provided during graduation.
- Balloons, whistles, flowers, noise makers, etc. are not allowed into the FORD Center
- Flowers will be for sale on site at the ceremony.
- Parking for graduation will be in the garages at FORD Center. There will not be shuttles to graduations occurring at the FORD Center at the STAR.
- Doors will open one hour before the ceremony (8:30am)
- There is no reserved seating for graduation.
- Following the ceremony, students will be escorted to the front of FORD Center at the STAR/Tostidos Arena to meet their families. Students will not be allowed back stage/to the staging area following the ceremony.

Monday, June 10th

Beginning Monday, June 10th CHS graduates may pick up their graduation packets in the front office of CHS from 8–11:30am and from 1–3:30pm Monday-Thursday through the end of June. The front office will be closed every Friday through June and July. Graduation packets include senior's diploma and school records.
