Guidelines & Criteria

Manju & Dr. Kumar scholarship aims to serve and assist financially challenged students in the Dallas Fort Worth metropolis (DFW), who plans to pursue higher education. The scholarship is designed to help selected students achieve their goals of educational excellence despite their financial difficulties. The scholarship will assist selected students by providing them with \$1000.00 award.

In order to apply for the scholarship, students must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Must be a resident of Dallas Fort Worth metropolis (DFW) for at least 4 years.
- 2. Be committed to attend a 4-year university undergraduate program on a full-time basis
- 3. High school grade point average (GPA) at or above 3.8.
- 4. Demonstrate a financial need.
- 5. A one-page essay explaining why you should get this scholarship, what are the goals and aspirations for the future and how you will use the undergraduate education for

the benefit of the community (List any extracurricular activities, volunteer work, and/or hobbies in which you participate or have participated over the past three years, noting any special awards you may have received).

6. Provide transcript of SAT/ACT scores.

Final selection of the scholarship winners will be decided by in collaboration and approval of the Board of Directors of Manju & Dr. Kumar Scholarship Fund and UPASNA Executive Committee.

No member of the UPASNA Scholarship Committee, Manju & Dr. Kumar Scholarship Fund, Board or their immediate family is eligible for this scholarship assistance.

UPASNA shall notify the chosen scholarship recipient(s) of its decision. The scholarship payment will be made after UPASNA reviews and verifies the college that the student will be attending. Payment will be made directly through Dean/Student Financial Aid office of University/school.

Completed applications must be received by 11:59 pm (Central) on May 31, 2019
