Logistics

- 1st and 2nd periods (including Flex)- TESTING
- 3rd and 4th period B day after testing ends
- Calculators will be provided to all PSAT testing students.
- No cell phones, electronic devices, back packs, food/snacks will be allowed in the testing room. Leave them in your car or locker.
- No food or drinks (including bottled water) are allowed without student pre-approval by College Board SSD.

Results

 The PSAT score reports are due to arrive in January. The reports and test booklets will be distributed through the students' Social Studies classes.

PSAT – Pre Administration

- During Flex Time on September 20th and 22nd
- 10th and 11th grade students will report to your PSAT testing room and complete the demographic information on your answer sheet
- Look/complete at the handout (half sheet) ahead of time so you will be prepared to complete this info on these days (put it in your binder when done so you have it).

SAT Test

- No penalty for wrong answers
- Computer based option
- Option to test with or without Writing section (<u>better to</u> test WITH writing)
- Calculator only allowed in the longer of two math sections
- Score is 400-1600 (Math/Reading and Writing)

- No penalty for wrong answers
- Option to test with or without Writing section (better to test WITH writing)
- Includes a Science section
- Calculator allowed on the entire math section
- Score is 1-36 Composite Score (Reading/Math/Science/English)



Top 10% Rule – Texas

- Must take four core classes for four years, including Algebra 2 (Distinguished Level of Achievement)
- Uses GPA/Class Rank from 6th semester (end of Junior Year)
- Guarantees admission to any public Texas College for which you apply (not necessarily the major you want)
- UT Austin sets their own percentage each fall
 - Class of 2017 Top 7%
 - Class of 2018 hasn't been determined yet
 Each fall, the university notifies Texas school officials of the class rank that current high school juniors need to attain by the end of their junior year in order to be automatically admitted.

Class Rank/GPA

- Grades
- PAP/AP course work
- Uses the 6th semester ranking for College Applications
- <u>Meet College Entrance Requirements-</u> check your colleges (Foundation/Endorsements/Distinguished Level of Achievement)
- SAT/ACT Test Scores
- Involvement in School/Outside of School/Work
- Special Talent/Hobby/Passion
- Article: "Applying Sideways"

- BE A WELL ROUNDED STUDENT!

How to Choose?

Visit colleges

- Call the school for an appointment/check website for Preview Days
- · Go when students are in session, if at all possible
- Bring back paper documentation from the school and turn it in to the attendance office – 2 visits allowed as a junior
- Narrow down list to 3-5 you will apply to STARTING in Summer/August of Senior year
- Apply to at least one school in each category:
 - Reach school
 - Reality school
 - Safety Net school

Junior Year Timeline

- Fall- PSAT, Online College Searches
- Winter- sign up and take SAT/ACT or both for the 1st time
 - Fee Waivers are available for Free/Reduced

 Spring- Visit Potential Colleges, Retake SAT/ACT if necessary; register for NCAA Eligibility Center

Summer/Fall Senior Year

- Summer- Update Resume, Finalize College List
- Applications open starting July 2018
- Early Deadlines may start October 15th (this is usually the earliest)
- Check on Rolling Admissions/Regular Decision
- Counselors will visit Senior classes Early Fall to explain application process/answer your questions before you complete/submit applications.
- Process will also be on Family Connection Home page starting June 2018.

Community Service Hours

- www.X2VOL.com
- School email login/ ID Number password
- Hours will be verified by email to the sponsorrecord hours within 7 days of completing so credit is awarded
- April 1st deadline of senior year
- Not required- but highly encouraged!
