Frisco High School Prom Dress Code

Formal Attire is Expected

Ladies:

- Dresses need to be modestly cut in the front so as not to show too much cleavage; plunging necklines are not allowed.
- Two-piece or bra-top type dresses are not acceptable.
- No see through tops or bra-tops
- All dresses must cover the mid-riff region and be modest in style with no sheer fabric.
 "Mesh" that attaches a bra top to a skirt bottom, thus making it a one piece dress will not be allowed.
- No slits (front, back, or side) higher than the finger tip length in a standing position
- Strapless dresses, dress with spaghetti straps or halter top dresses that meet the requirements listed in these guidelines are APPROVED dresses.

Gentlemen:

- Dress suit and tie or tuxedo (no jeans)
- Appropriate footwear must be worn: no flip flops or athletic shoes, etc.
- Non-formal headwear (baseball caps, do rags, bandannas, etc) will not be allowed.
- Formal dress hats that go with the tuxedo or suit are acceptable.
