

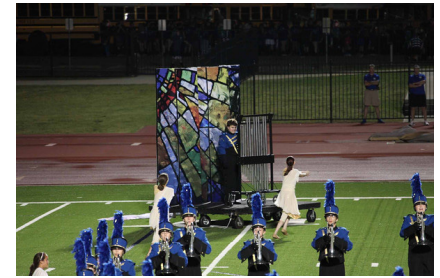

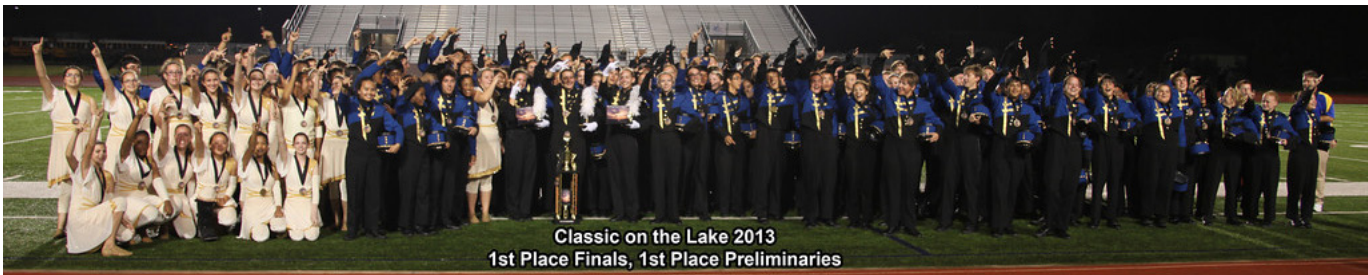
## Award Winning Band:
