**Test Security: Cell phones and electronic devices:** Cell Phones will not be allowed in the Testing Area/Room. Please make sure that it is in your locker PRIOR to your testing time.

#### Pencils and bottled water:

Please bring two sharpened #2 pencils to their testing room. You may also bring a closed bottle of water to the testing room, which you will be advised to keep on the floor to avoid damaging your testing documents.

Sack Lunches for English STAAR exams (English I on March 30 and English II on April 1): The English I and English II STAAR EOC exams are 5 hours in length. The tests will be stopped to allow the students a lunch break in their testing room. All students who are testing in these exams will need a sack lunch. Students were provided an opportunity to pre-order a sack lunch from the cafeteria. If a student pre-orders a sack lunch, the student's account will be billed, regardless of whether the

student decides to eat the sack lunch on test day.

\*\* Students will not be allowed to receive lunch deliveries or visit the Cafeteria on their testing day. \*\*
