

The Yearbooks are Coming:

It's almost time for the unveiling of the 2013-2014 yearbook. Students who already purchased a book will be able to pick it up between June 2 and June 4. Seniors can pick up their books before school on Monday, June 2, in the concessions area of the gym. Underclassmen can pick up their books during all lunches or after school on June 2, or before school and during

all lunches on Tuesday, June 3. Students will need to listen to the announcements to find out where books will be handed out Wednesday, June 4. A current driver's license or school id card with a photograph is required to pick up your yearbook. Check the list posted in downstairs E-Hall to make sure you do not miss out on this year's yearbook.

If your name is not on the list, it is not too late. You can purchase a book by going to mypaymentsplus.com, and under the miscellaneous tab, there is an option to purchase a 2014 yearbook. Make sure to pay ahead of time because books will not be sold at distribution, and once the extra books are sold, there will be no more.

Seniors TO DO List:

1. Make sure that you have cleared your name from the HOLD List!
2. Make sure that you have marked your calendar for **MANDATORY** Graduation Practice on Thursday June 5th from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. in the FHS gym. You must be in the FHS Gym AND SEATED by 4:30 p.m. Mandatory attendance at practice is required to walk at the graduation ceremony. Graduation tickets will be handed out after practice concludes. **Students must be off any hold or fee list in order to collect your Senior Packet containing your Graduation Tickets.** Did

- you forget to order your extra tickets? See Mrs. Brashear right after the conclusion of Graduation Practice. ***Dress code still applies for Graduation Practice.***
3. Graduation: Saturday, June 7th at 4:00 p.m. ***BUT*** you need to mark your calendar to meet the mandatory bus to graduation at 2:00 p.m. in the Frisco High School GYM. All seniors will be shuttled by bus from FHS to the Dr. Pepper Arena. Graduates must be at Frisco High School Gym by 2:00 p.m. on graduation day. The buses will leave promptly at 2:30 p.m.

- Please make sure to leave all personal items (e.g. purses, cell phones, cameras, etc.) with family prior to loading the bus. Items cannot be left on the bus. Buses will be available following the ceremony to shuttle any graduates requiring transportation back to FHS. Signs will be posted around the school telling students which Graduation Bus they will need to ride to Graduation.
