2018-2019 Secondary Gifted Referral Information January 10 – 25, 2019



Parents, teachers, school administrators, students, and community members may refer a child for gifted screening. Please note, if the student tested in the spring or fall of 2018, he/she is not eligible for testing.

Referral Window: January 10 – 25, 2019

Secondary campus GT teachers will begin taking names of referred students January 10th, and referral links will be sent to parents/guardians Jan 11th. Please look for an email from <u>GiftedTalented@friscoisd.org</u> to access the referral link. Emailed referral links will become inactive at midnight January 25, 2019, and no referrals will be processed after that time. Please do not wait until the deadline to complete a referral.
