1. We will be talking a lot this year about "coming of age." "Coming of age" means "growing up and becoming mature."
How does Equality "come of age" in this book?

2.	We will also be talking a lot about "heroism" this year. "Heroism" means "being a hero."
	In what ways does Equality display heroism?

4.	"Juxtaposition" is when an author puts two very different things right next to each other in a book. For instance, the author may "juxtapose" lightness and darkness or civilization and barbarism. Find one instance of "juxtaposition" in <i>Anthem</i> . What is the significance of this juxtaposition?

5.	A "theme" is an underlying message in a work of literature. For example, a theme of a work might be that "true friendship requires mutual trust" or "making a decision too quickly can lead to bad consequences." What is a theme of <i>Anthem</i> ? Where do you find this theme in the book?
