Heritage Counseling Center Steps to College Admissions

Four-Year University Applicants

Junior Year

- Click on About Me and update Profile in Family Connection. Also complete My Game Plan. Go to www.connection.naviance.com/heritage.
- Add colleges you are interested in to Family Connection under "My Colleges."
- Take the ACT and/or SAT Reasoning Test. Go to www.act.org for ACT or www.sat.org for SAT. <u>Send</u> your scores to anticipated colleges.
- Take the SAT subject tests if required.

Senior Year

- Apply online between Aug 1 and Thanksgiving.
 - For Texas public schools, apply at www.applytexas.org.
 - For private schools, apply directly to the school, preferably online or check the private common application at www.commonapp.org to see if the school uses this application.
 - Move colleges to the "Applied" section of Family Connection.
- Send in your application fee to the school.
- Send your test scores to the university (if you did not do so when you registered to test). You must request these directly from SAT or ACT.
- If you need a letter of recommendation, follow the steps in your senior folder.
- Check Family Connection for scholarships.
- Sign a transcript release form in the counseling office if your parent checked no on the annual online registration for releasing information to colleges..
- Request your transcript at Family Connection and pay your transcript fee in the counseling office.
- Apply for housing.
- For Texas state schools, take the THEA test if you are not exempt. Go to www.thea.nesinc.com. Exemption criteria -
 - 2200 math and ELA Exit Level TAKS scores with a 3 on the essay.
 - 1070 on SAT critical reading and math, with a 500 on each section.
 - 23 on ACT composite score with a 19 on math and English sections.
- Apply for the parent and student FAFSA PIN number in the fall at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- Apply for financial aid at www.fafsa.ed.gov <u>after</u> January 1.
- Compare your offers from the universities in the spring.
- Notify all universities of your decision to attend, or not to attend, their institution by May 1.
- If you have college dual credit hours, request a final transcript from Collin College be sent to your school.
- Complete the "Graduation Survey" at Family Connection. <u>This step will process your final</u> <u>transcript request.</u>

Two-Year College Applicants

- Add colleges you are interested in to Family Connection under "My Colleges."
- Take the Compass test in the spring if not exempt. Call the testing center at Collin College at 972-377-1523 to schedule a test.

Exemption criteria -

- 2200 math and ELA Exit Level TAKS score with a 3 on the essay.
- 1070 on SAT critical reading and math, with a 500 on each section.
- 23 on ACT composite score with a 19 on math and English sections.
- Sign a transcript release form in the counseling office if your parent checked no on the annual online registration for releasing information to colleges.
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- Apply for financial aid at www.fafsa.ed.gov <u>after</u> January 1.
- Complete the "Graduation Survey" at Family Connection. <u>This step will process your final</u> <u>transcript request.</u>
- Apply at www.applytexas.org in the spring.
