The ads will give parents, grand parents, sports teams and clubs the opportunity to tell their graduate(s) congratulations and to show how proud of them you are in a special way.

We can help you create lasting memories for your senior!

How it works:

- The purchaser will submit text and pictures. As well as design suggestions. For example, if your student loves the color purple, tell us so that we can include that color in your ad. We want to make sure you love the ad, so be sure to tell us if you want anything special.
- Our yearbook staff will design an ad unique to your student.
- Once we have created your ad, we will email it to the email address you provided for approval. Once we email you a copy of your ad, you have **one week** to respond to the email.

Photo Submission Guidelines:

Please read these BEFORE sending in photos. Your photos must meet these guidelines in order to work with our software and our publisher.

- Make sure your senior photos are taken and you will have them in time to meet the deadline if you plan to include them in your ad. Ads will not be delayed to wait for your photos.
- We prefer to receive digital picture files. Only .jpg or .tif files can be used and the resolution must be at least 300 dpi. Files maybe emailed to Ms. Morgan at Morganl@friscoisd.org with the student's name in the subject line. Files also may be sent on a CD or brought on a flash drive.
- If you choose to submit physical pictures, please submit a copy of the photo. We can not be responsible for lost or damaged photographs. All physical pictures must be printed in color and printed on photo quality paper. Please write your student's name on each picture you submit.
- If other students are in the photo, please make sure you have permission to use their photo in the ad.
- We cannot accept pdf files.

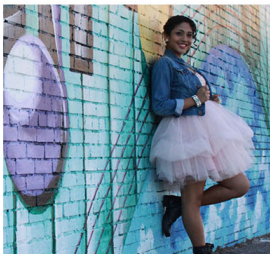

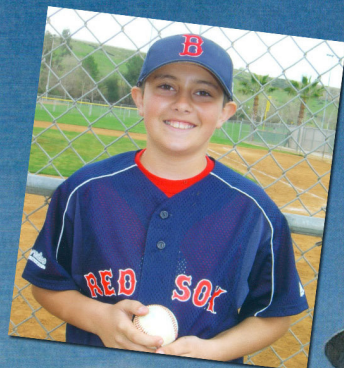
