# Simultaneously earn high school <u>and</u> college credit in <u>one</u> class!

This <u>includes</u> online courses!

## Benefits of Being a Collin College Dual Credit Student

## **Dual Credit Eligibility**

- Students complete the <u>entire</u> Collin College admissions process plus a permission form for registration.
- Available with permission from your high school each semester for every course.
- Must meet college readiness standards as defined by Texas Success Initiative (TSI).
- Student must meet both high school and Collin College academic requirements to continue in the dual credit program.
  - ➢ If numeric grade of 60-69% is awarded in dual credit course, student will receive an on-level 70% on high school transcript. Letter grade of D will be listed on Collin College transcript.
  - Will not be eligible to continue with dual credit in that subject. Must enroll in high school section for next semester.

# Is Dual Credit the Right Choice for Everyone?

Parents and students should consider goals, maturity, responsibility, and academic ability levels prior to enrolling in a dual credit program.



# How Do I Check for HOLDS on My Account?


#### **Instructions**

## **Pay Tuition**

\$50 per credit hour for students residing in Collin County
= \$152 for a 3 credit hour course

\$96 per credit hour for students residing in Denton County
= \$290 for a 3 credit hour course


Total cost per 3 credit hour course includes a \$2 per semester student records fee.
