Ranger Academy—August 8

Kensie Shirack Assistant Principal Ranger Academy is an orientation for the incoming Class of 2020. Students are asked to arrive between 8:00-8:30 am for check-in at the school's gym entrance. Ranger Academy will conclude by 11:30 pm. **Students are expected to stay the entire time**. In order to participate in this orientation, the online registration process must be completed (Info Snap), and students must **bring proof of residency*** (**POR**). Students can receive a *FAST Pass* by dropping off a POR at the LSHS front office now. After all paperwork is submitted, students will complete a variety of activities ending with a full class assembly in the auditorium. At the conclusion of the assembly, students will begin the check-out process by picking up their schedules. After students receive their schedules, the building will be open so students can walk the building and try out their lockers. Parents are welcome to stay through the pep rally and can return at 11:00 to walk the building with their students. All other activities are for students

Schedule Pick-Up—August 9

The August 9th Schedule Pick-Up is for the Classes of 2017, 2018, and 2019 from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm. Students from any of the classes may come at any time during these hours. *Be aware that check-in will close from Noon –1:00 pm.* Active student organizations will get directions from their coaches or sponsors for their time to attend Schedule Pick-up. In order to begin this process, the online registration process must be completed (Info Snap), and students must bring with them **proof of residency* (POR)**. Students can receive a *FAST Pass* by dropping off a POR at the LSHS front office now. In addition, students must be cleared from the LSHS HOLD list. **Students are expected to complete all facets of the Schedule Pick-up process which will conclude with students receiving their schedules.**

If you are out of town during this time, an abbreviated day is scheduled for Thursday, August 18 from 1:00-4:00 pm in the cafeteria.

Legacy Studios will be taking Student Portraits during the school day on August 29-31. Information will follow at a later date.

CLASS DUES

A portion of Class Dues is collected each year which covers the cost of each student's senior t-shirt, senior prom ticket and senior breakfast. Class dues will total \$85. Students will pay \$25 each year and \$10 in their senior year. Payment is due by October 1st each year. Classes of 2018, 2019 & 2020 can pay Class Dues through **My Payments Plus**. The Classes of 2017 can make checks payable to the LSHS – Class of 2017. Class Dues are non-transferable. Refunds must be requested by October 1st of a student's senior year. If dues are not paid in full by October 1st of a student's senior year, the individual cost for each item is as follows: Senior T-Shirt \$15; Senior Prom \$75; Senior Breakfast \$10. Seniors may purchase ONE Guest ticket for prom at the cost of \$75.*Seniors 2017—See enclosed statement. (continued on back)

August 22, 2016 is the first day of school. We will have special activities during the first three days of school. Students traveling to the CTE center or other campuses will be expected to do so at their scheduled time.

Students can order a copy of *The Dispatch*, the LSHS Yearbook, now. The discounted price of \$65 for this all-color book will be available until September 18. After that day the cost will increase. Yearbooks are pre-order only with personalization included and delivery at the end of the school year. Yearbook orders can be turned in during the schedule pick-up process or you can also order online at www.jostens.com. Yearbook order forms are enclosed for your convenience. All Yearbook sales are final.
