

FISD Bond Program 2014

On Saturday, May 10, 2014, the citizens of the Frisco Independent School District will be asked to consider a \$775 million bond package to provide educational facilities for up to 66,000 students. PASA Demographics currently projects Frisco ISD will reach that enrollment figure in 2020. The plan was developed by a committee of 27 parents and community members. Ultimately, the group proposed a package that includes new schools, additions and land purchases, instructional and student support needs, and renovations to support facilities. Trustees accepted the proposal at the February 10th regular meeting of the Board and called a bond election for May 10, 2014.
