## 2017-2018 Gifted Referral Information January 3 – 22, 2018



Parents, teachers, school administrators, students, and community members may refer a child for gifted screening. Please note, if the student tested in the spring or fall of 2017, he/she is not eligible for testing.

Referrals may be made for the following grade levels:

Elementary School – 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>

Middle School – 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup>

High School – 9<sup>th</sup>, 10, and 11<sup>th</sup>

## Referral Window: January 3 – 22, 2018

Campus GT teachers will begin taking names of referred students January 3<sup>rd</sup>, and referral links will be sent to parents/guardians Jan 8<sup>th</sup>. Please look for an email from <u>GiftedTalented@friscoisd.org</u> to access the referral link. Emailed referral links will become inactive at midnight January 22, 2018, and no referrals will be processed after that time. Please do not wait until the deadline to complete a referral.
