

Student Registration Information

By signing below, the parent/guardian understands and acknowledges the following statements:

Pre-AP, Pre-AP Algebra I, and Spanish Expectations

Students are encouraged to challenge themselves by taking Pre-AP courses, but should expect an additional time requirement. A student who earns below a 70% in two consecutive six week grading periods will be placed on academic probation and a committee including the student, parent, and teacher will convene to develop a plan for future success. If at the conclusion of the six weeks of probation the student again earns below a 70%, the committee will reconvene to determine if enrollment in the course is the appropriate placement.

In order to enroll in PAP Algebra I, a student must either:

--Complete PAP Math 7 and show proficiency on an Algebra readiness test given in the spring.

Or

--Complete Math 7, and score 80% or higher on the 8th grade math Exam for Acceleration, and show proficiency on an Algebra readiness test given in the spring.

High School Credit Course Expectations

Middle school students enrolled in high school courses should expect high standards and an additional time requirement. Beginning with the class of 2017, high school courses taken in middle school will count in a student's high school GPA calculation. Students must follow all high school requirements for these courses. More information on how GPA will be calculated for these courses can be obtained from your student's counselor. Parents of students enrolled in high school credited courses are encouraged to read the high school course catalog, the high school academic guide, and the academic portion of the high school handbook. Instruction to Support Future Academic Success (all grade levels)

Students identified as needing additional math and/or reading instruction will be placed into a Math and/or Reading Lab class. This class will take the place of an elective class or 6th grade PE. Texas Administrative Code requires remediation for any student who fails to demonstrate satisfactory performance on any section of the State assessments of academic skills. In addition, students who narrowly met State assessment passing standards may be included in remediation during and before or after the regular school day.

New Students

Students transferring from another Texas school must provide STAAR results from the most recent administration. If STAAR results are not available immediately, please note that necessary schedule changes will be made to address any academic needs once they are received. If a student enrolls from out of state, private school, or home school, the student will complete assessments to determine if a STAAR preparation course(s) will be required.

Schedule Changes

Schedule change requests are subject to availability in the class requested, student need, and master scheduling issues. Students need to choose classes carefully. Schedule change requests will be accepted during the first week of school. A schedule change request does not guarantee that a schedule change will occur. All schedule changes must be approved by the principal or principal's designee.

Elective Course Selection

While every effort will be made to schedule students into the elective courses of their choosing, students are not guaranteed enrollment in elective courses. Enrollment numbers and master scheduling conflicts can result in a student having to be enrolled in an alternative elective choice.
