“May we think of freedom, not as the right to do as we please, but as the opportunity to do what is right .” –Peter Marshall

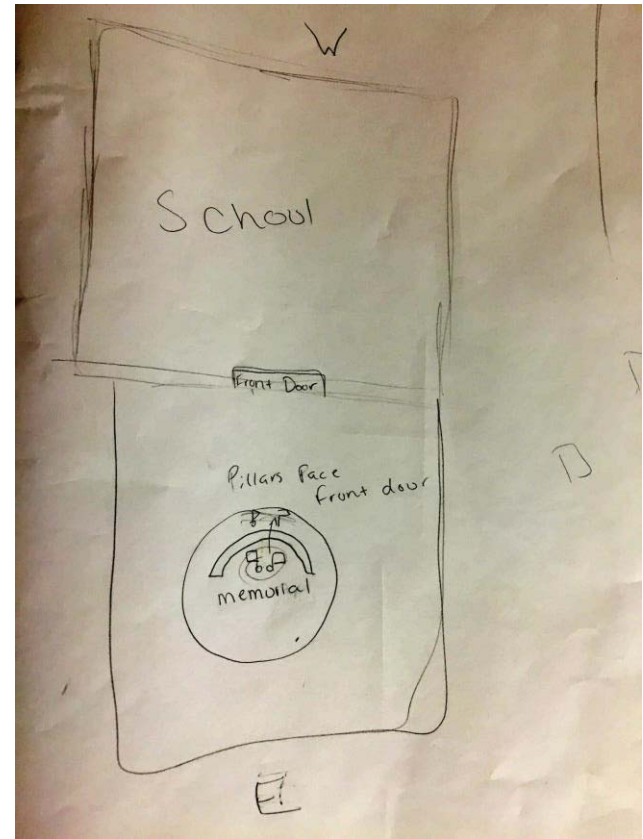
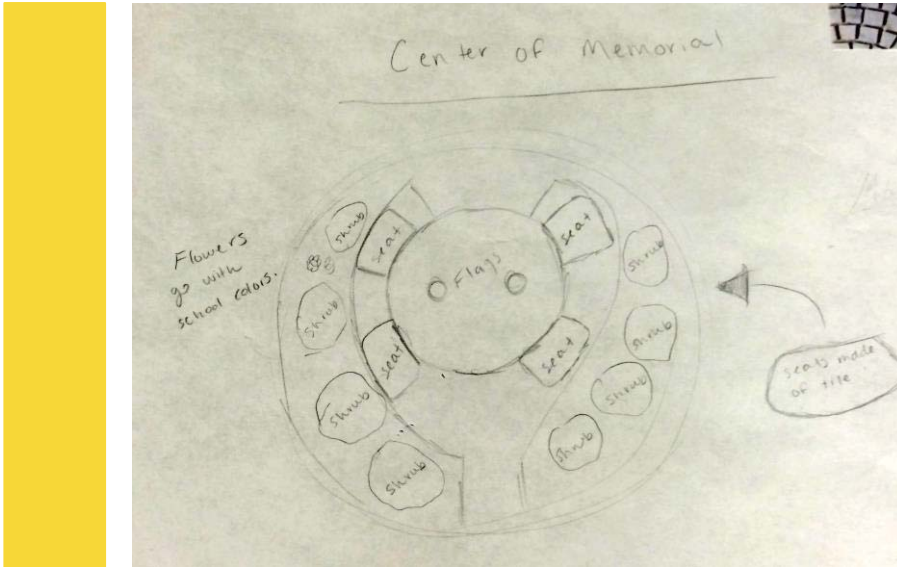
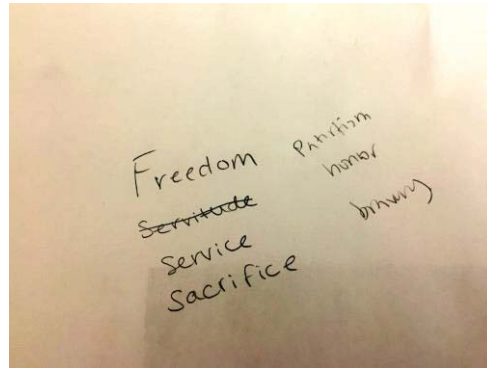
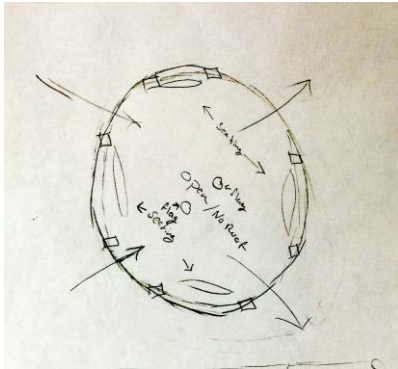

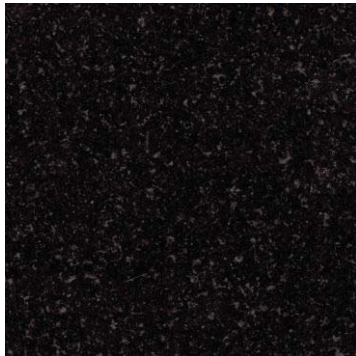
Improved Sketch

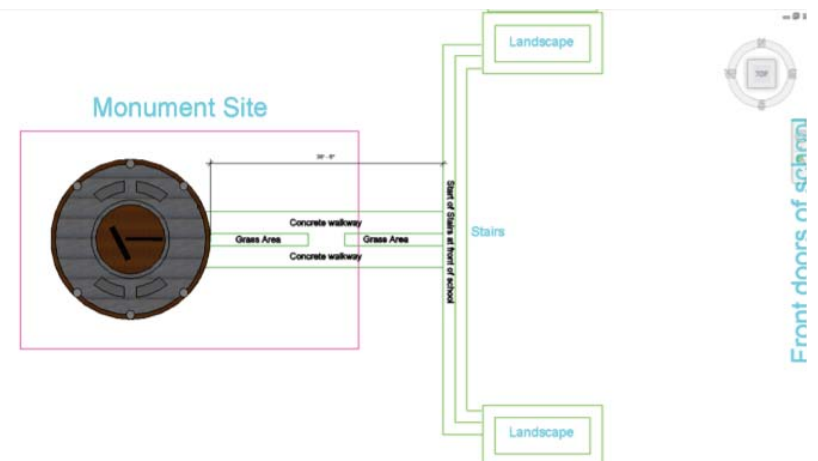
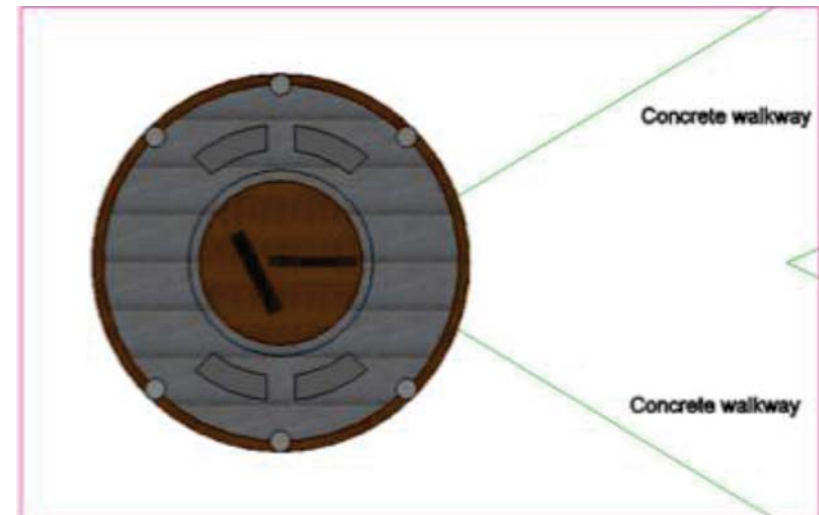
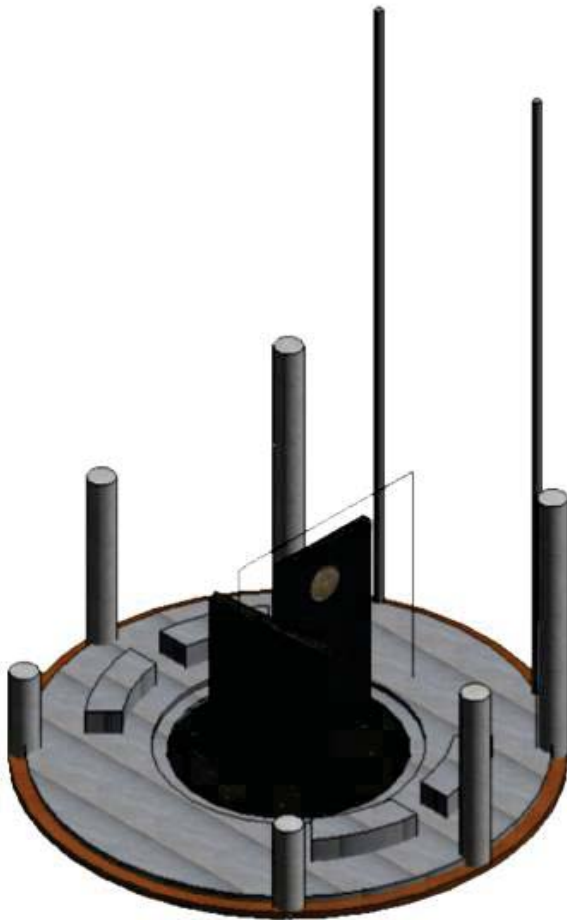


- ❑ Tablets: Black granite, or similar material

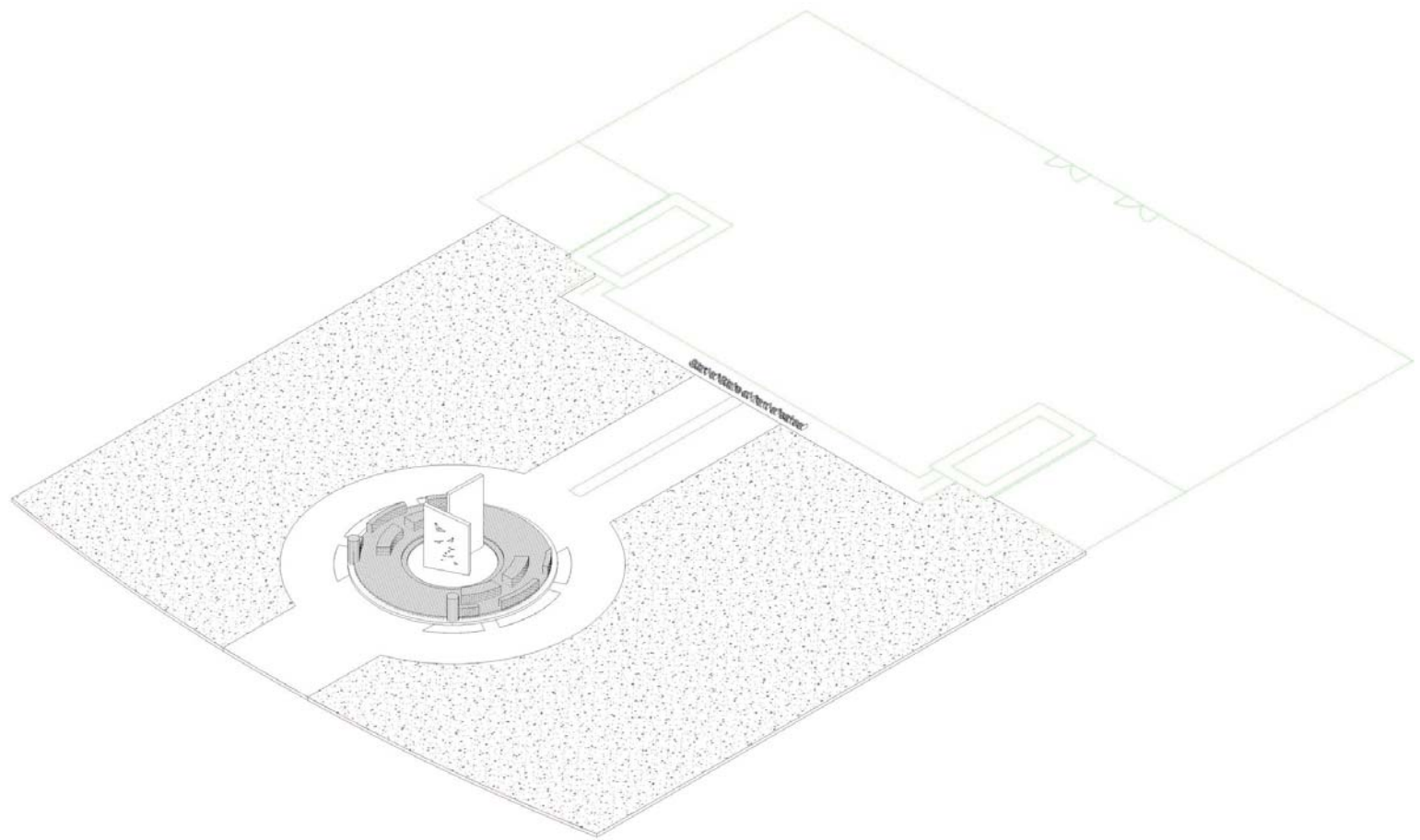
