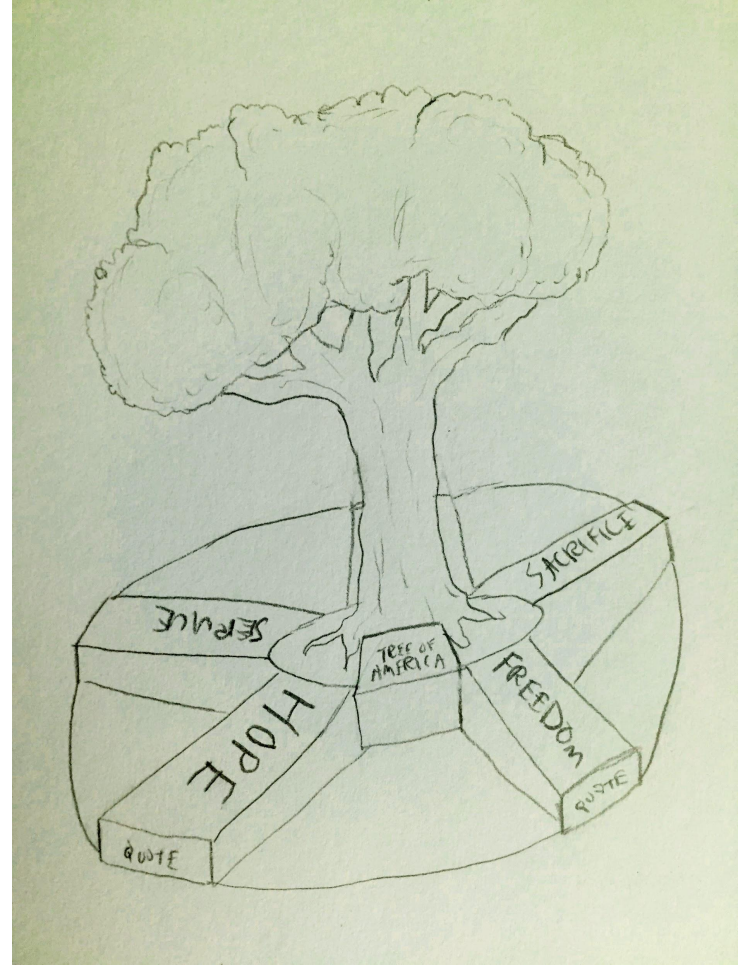
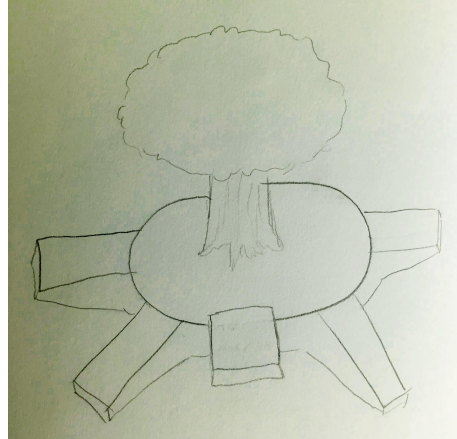
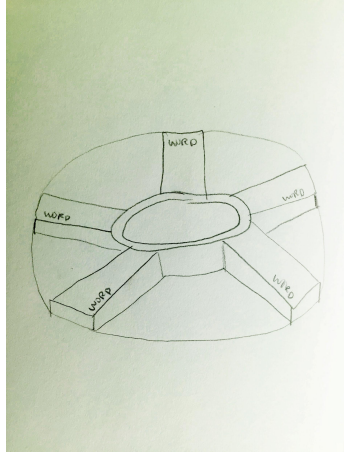
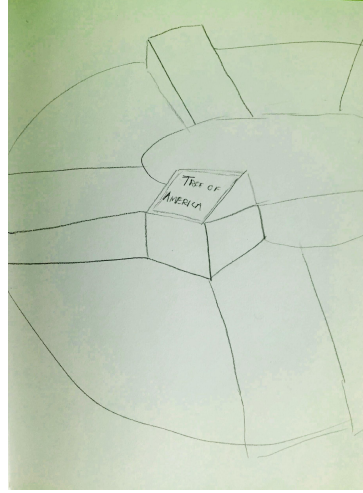
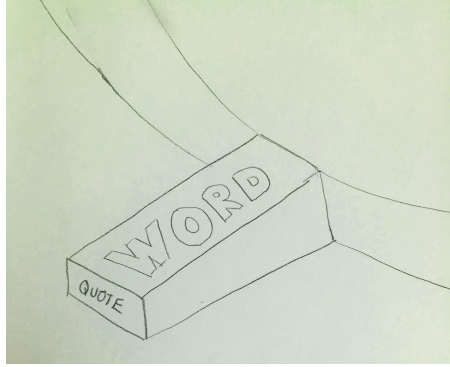
New Concepts
