Political Science (1 credit—11th-12th)

Prerequisite: Law I or Court Systems



Comparative Political Science

This course will familiarize the student with political and legal theory through the study of international governmental systems, as well as the United States court system; governmental systems; public policies; and political processes, systems, and behaviors.

This course will focus on International governmental systems in particular, as well as, global political economy, and social movements. The class also participates in a national Supreme Court competition each year designed around on case before the court that term.
