<p>Goal 1: Enhance academic, behavioral, and social-emotional outcomes for all students by strengthening the implementation and monitoring of a campus-wide Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) and Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS).</p> <p>Evidence of Success: By May 2026, Memorial High School will implement and monitor a comprehensive MTSS/MTSS-B framework, resulting in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">-100% of Tier 2 and Tier 3 students having documented intervention plans in academics and/or behavior.-A 10% reduction in repeated behavior referrals for Tier 2/3 students compared to 2024-2025 baseline data.-100% of staff trained annually on PBIS expectations and MTSS protocols, with implementation fidelity monitored quarterly. <p>Staff Responsible: Associate Principal, Assistant Principals, Instructional Coaches</p>
