## About Our Community

Frisco is an upper middle class community located approximately 25 miles north of Dallas, Texas. Frisco ISD is one of the fastest growing districts in the nation. The community has a current population of 150,000. The district instructs over 50,000 students and has 65 campuses.

## About Our School

Centennial High School has set a high standard of excellence. CHS has an enrollment of 2,041 students in grades 9-12. CHS is accredited by the Texas Education Agency and has earned a rating of Exemplary. Ninety percent of the student body is college-bound. Fifty-five percent attend four year schools, and thirty-five percent attend two year schools. The senior class of 2015 (532 students) earned scholarship offers totaling more than \$15 million. While students are encouraged to volunteer in the community, community service hours are not required for graduation.

## Rank In Class

Class rank is based on cumulative, weighted semester averages from grades 9-12. Pre-AP, AP and dual credit courses are weighted. All courses are included in rank except courses taken in junior high, summer school, correspondence classes and classes such as Study Skills, Office Aide, and Teacher Aide.

## Grade Scale

CHS awards grade points on a weighted 5.0 scale. Pre-AP, AP and dual credit courses receive additional grade points (see chart on reverse side).
